The Helping the Working Poor Tax Credit was established by the Arizona State Legislature to provide financial assistance to Arizona registered 501(c)(3) non profits that spend at least 50% of their budget on services to Arizona residents who receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families benefits or to Arizona residents that live in low-income or poverty levels. This tax credit opportunity differs from the school tax credit benefit.

To encourage cash charitable contributions, the Arizona State Legislature allows most donors to take up to \$200 (\$400 per married couple) off their Arizona State taxes, based on the amount of the gift, in the form of a tax credit.

Check with your employer to see if they will match your contribution!

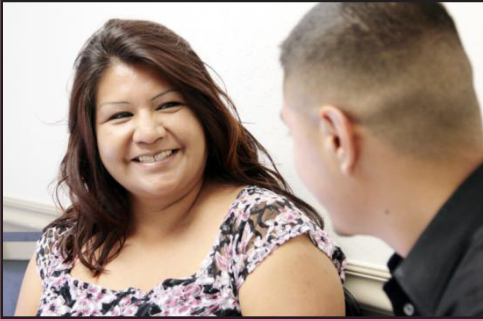

How will my contribution be used?

All contributions will be used to further the **TERROS** mission of helping people hope, cope and get better.

If the intent of your donation is not specified, it will go to the program with the greatest need at that time.

TERROS has used these funds in a variety of ways to improve physical and mental health and the overall well-being of people addressing challenges of addiction and mental illness.

TERROS is a non-profit 501(c)(3) community based organization that offers a wide variety of behavioral health prevention, education and treatment services. We provide a continuum of care that matches treatment to the specific needs of individuals and families.

How is a tax credit different than a tax deduction?

A tax credit is applied to reduce tax liability dollar-for-dollar. A tax deduction is an expense that reduces taxable income. Helping the Working Poor Tax Credit is an actual credit off the amount you pay in state taxes.

Can I still claim this on my Federal tax return as a contribution?

Yes; your entire contribution is also eligible as a tax deduction on your Federal tax return.

How do I document my contribution?

TERROS will send you a *Thank You* letter confirming your donation.

Can I take the tax credit if I don't owe any money to the State of Arizona when I file my taxes?

As long as you have a tax liability and you qualify through previous years itemized deductions, the credit will increase your refund.

What do I do to file for the credit?

You or your accountant needs to complete AZ Form 321 to claim the credit. The form or link is included with materials provided by the State of Arizona to all state tax filers.

Who can take advantage of the Arizona Tax Credit?

Any individual who files and pays Arizona income tax is eligible for this credit. In order to receive your 2011 tax credit, your donation must be *postmarked or received* before December 31, 2011.
